### About The Singapore LSE Trust Scholarship

The applicant of the Scholarship has to first gain admission to an LSE undergraduate programme, and must be a Singapore citizen. The applicant is assessed by LSE's Financial Support Office to have a genuine financial need and is determined by the Trustees of The Singapore LSE Trust to be "someone special" – a person who has a special social conscience with a proven track record in making a difference to the social causes they believe in.

Successful applicants can expect to have their tuition fees paid for, estimated at around £50,000 in total over the course of the applicant's 3-year studies.
